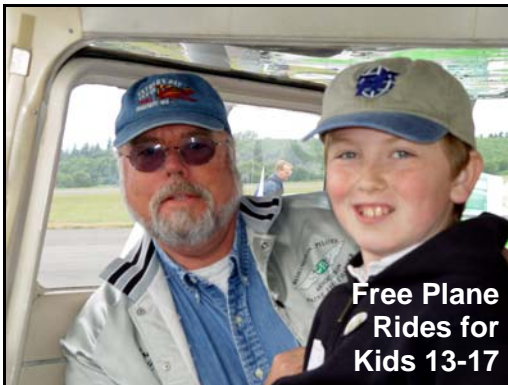
## “Taste of Mukilteo”

### Review Panel for the Paine Field Mediated Role Determination

Snohomish County's Mediated Role Determination (MRD) panel will hold its third meeting on Thursday, April 6 from 2:30 p.m. to 4:30 p.m. on the first floor of the County Administration Building East, 3000 Rockefeller Ave., Everett. The meetings are all open to the public and there will be an opportunity for public comments.

The MRD is being reviewed for the first time in 30 years. The job of the MRD panel is to review and make recommendations on Paine Field's current and future role based on updated studies and relevant data. Upon completion, the County Executive will ask the panel to present its update to the County Council for consideration.

The Agenda for the next meeting includes: Review of Mission and Objectives of the MRD Panel, a session called Airport 101 (Federal Aviation Regulations, Grant Assurances/Deed Covenants, Part 139 Airport Certification, ANCA – Airport Noise and Capacity Act, Part 161 Airport Noise and Access Restrictions), FAA Master Plan Program Overview, Paine Field Master Plan, Aviation Noise Science, Metrics and Legal Overview, Part 36 Noise Standard Definition, Part 150 Noise Compatibility Study, Paine Field Noise History and Forecast, MRD Review Panel Website Update, Panel Discussion, Future Meetings and Agenda.
