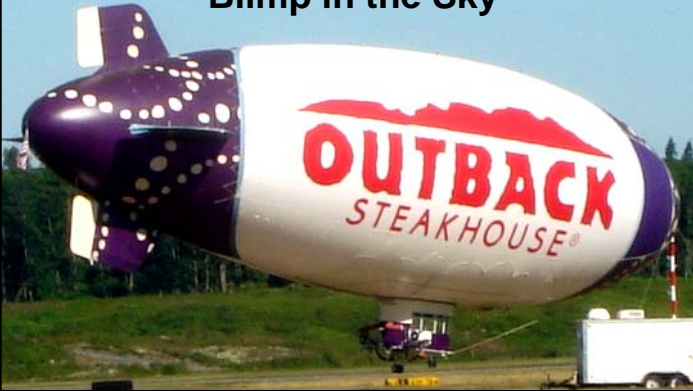

The Fly Days will take place at approximately 12 noon -1 p.m. Timing may be modified slightly due to technical issues and/or other air traffic at Paine Field. Patrons will be directed to the viewing area at 12:00 noon prior to planes taking off.

Hours of operation are from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. seven days a week. Prices are \$12 Adults, \$10 for Seniors and Military, \$8 Youth (6 - 15) children 5 and under are free and parking is free.
