Vehicle Parking

Motor vehicles and aircraft must stay adequately separated between the hangars and around the airfield. A parked vehicle may be an obstruction to a taxiing aircraft and signs are posted on the ends of many hangars and on Airport fences designating "No Parking" areas. In addition, the Airport ground vehicle policy states that all tenants should park their motor vehicles in their hangar or in their designated tie down space upon departing with their aircraft. It is a violation to park a motor vehicle under or near a "No Parking" sign. Violators will be ticketed or towed.

You may leave a motor vehicle in front of your hangar for only a short period of time and no longer than one hour when working in your hangar. We appreciate everyone's help in keeping the airfield safe. Please call Bryan Johnson at 353-2110 extension 2234 with questions.

Airport Lighting Project

Beginning the week of August 2, factory reps will be here to power up our new regulators that supply electricity to the Airfield. We anticipate having operating lights on runways 11-29 and 16L-34R, and taxiways Charlie, Delta, Foxtrot and Golf by Wednesday, August 4! The new standby generator was fired up for the first time and tested the last week of July. Remaining project work will include intermittent closures for the installation of new runway hold signs on 11-29 and 16L-34R. These signs should be installed by the end of August.

NEW RENTAL RATES For Central Ramp and Old West Ramp T-Hangars Effective September 1, 2004

T-hangar rental rates for the standard forty foot T-hangars will increase \$10.00 a month, from \$220.00 to \$230.00 per month effective September 1, 2004. This includes state leasehold excise tax. Larger T-hangars will have similar percentage rate adjustments.

September statements will reflect the new rate and will also include the increase in the security deposit. If you have questions about your rate, please call Susan Kern at 425-353-2110 (extension 2226).

Note to Autopay Customers: The Airport will automatically deduct the new rate and the security deposit increase in the normal September autopay cycle. Please call if you have questions.
