**"The Flying Gizmo Show II", Grades 3 – 8, one hour, 10am, 11:30, 1pm**

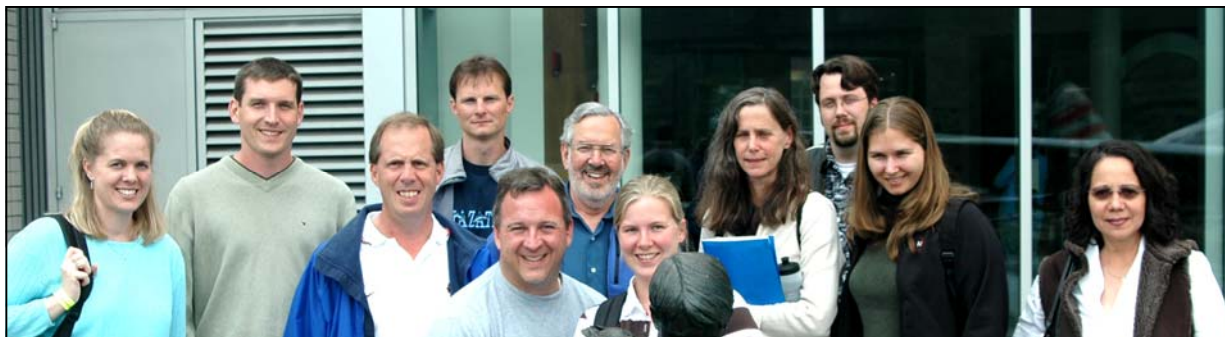
**"The Forces of Flight", Grades 1 – 6, one hour, 11am, 12:15pm**
