## Future of Flight—Grand Opening is October 22



### New access route for West Ramp tenants



Effective Tuesday, September 6, there will be a new access route to the west ramp hangars. Existing Gate S-2 (between Hangars 201 and 207) will close. The new gate, S-5, will be located north of the Fire Station and Me 262 project hangar. This change is necessary to accommodate a new tenant in Hangar 201 and the need to provide aviation access to this area. New signs will be installed to help people find their way to the new gate. Please watch

for pedestrians and vehicles along the new route. The change in access gates is necessary as Hangar Building 201 is once again an active aircraft storage facility with a surrounding Air Operations Area (AOA) ramp. Signage will be placed along 109<sup>th</sup> St. and 36<sup>th</sup> Pl. to help direct traffic. A new “zipper line” will be painted on the south ramp providing access route direction in the AOA. The access route is depicted on the attached sketch. Motorcycle riders will find an exit button to assist in exiting through the gate, while free exit loops will open the gate for other vehicles. Tenant cooperation is required to prevent follow through vehicles and personnel at Gate S5 and all other AOA access gates. ## New Maintenance Supervisor



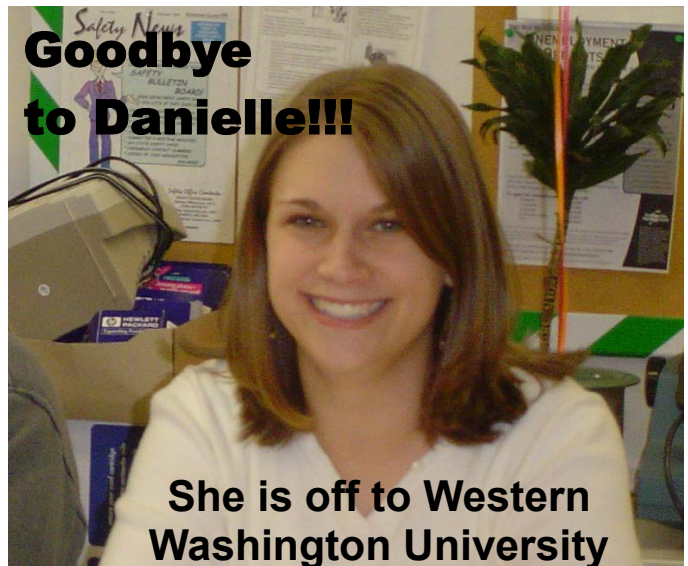
