Taxiway Whiskey will open soon! It was recently hydro-seeded and the contractor is in the final stages of completing the wiring for the taxiway lights. Once the lights are operational, crews will install new hold signs on runway 11-29. The hold lines were recently removed and repainted. As soon as the hold signs are installed, Taxiway Whiskey will open, hopefully in the first full week of October, and runway 11-29 should open around mid-October.

Communications Vault



Crews work on rebar placement for a new communications vault next to D1 and the inner terminal ramp. The new vault is the hub for all the fiber optic that runs on the Airport. The new vault is eight feet wide, 20 feet long and 8 feet tall. It has 38 yards of concrete weighing 152,000 lbs. and 7,000 feet of rebar which weighs 8 tons.
