NEW PAPI FOR RUNWAY 34L

The FAA will be commissioning a
new four box Precision Approach
Path Indicator (PAPI) to runway 34L
the first week in November. The new
PAPI will replace an existing VASI
that is 30 years old.

AVIATION CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

Runway 11-29 is finally open! Construction took significantly longer than originally planned in order to complete all the improvements on this runway and to the new taxiway Whiskey. We appreciate everyone's patience during construction.

The Airport has also received funds from the FAA to install new lighted hold signs at all the intersections on both 11-29 and 16L-34R. As weather permits, we will intermittently close intersections on both runways in order to pour concrete pads for the signs. Weather conditions will determine the timing and completion date of the sign project, but 10 of the 17 new signs have been installed.

The contractor has almost completed the taxiway lights on Whiskey. Once this is complete, taxiway Whiskey will also be opened.
